1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to dinghies of the following PY numbers. Multihull craft are not permitted.

Class	Flag	PY Band
Fast	Q	1010 and below
Medium	B	1011 -1110
Slow	W	1111 and above

Entries may be permitted on the day of the event providing the maximum number of boats has not been reached.

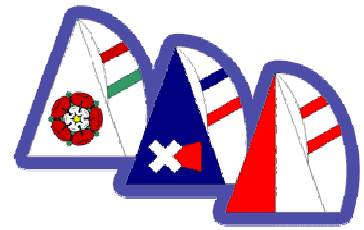
3.4 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply – entry is limited to a maximum of 100 boats

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Double Hander	£35	£15
Single Hander	£25	£10

4.2 Social tickets for sailors for each evening event are included in the entry fee. Extra tickets may be purchased at registration.



5 SERIES

The regatta will consist of a five race series, two races on Saturday 30th April and Sunday 1st, May and one race on Monday 2nd May.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available from the event website www.langstonerace.co.uk no later than Friday 15th April 2011 and also at registration.

8 Venue

8.1 The location of the regatta will be in and around the waters of Langstone Harbour.

8.2 The location of the racing marks within the harbour can be found on the published chart, although additional temporary marks will be deployed during the races. A copy of the racing marks chart will be available on the event website (www.langstonerace.co.uk) and also be provided to competitors at registration.

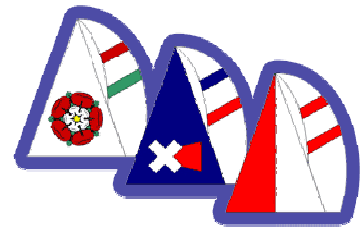
9 THE COURSE

9.1 The course will be set in Langstone Harbour using a combination of Langstone Harbour Navigation Marks & laid inflatable buoys.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

10.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.



- 10.3 (a) When two or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When three or four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11 BERTHING

Boat storage facilities for visiting dinghies are available at Tudor SC, Langstone SC & Locks SC

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows

To the 1st three Boats in each fleet for the series.

There is a daily prize for the winner on corrected time of the fast, medium & slow fleets, on days when there are more than one race both races are to count.

If there are more than eight boats in a one-design class they will receive a series prize for that class (with prizes awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places). These boats shall race within the relevant handicap fleet but their results will be excluded from the overall handicap fleet results.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
