6:00 PM	<b>Club Boat Allocation</b> Once you have been allocated a boat, please pay Anthea the fees , then retrieve the boat & sails and start rigging.
6:20 PM	<b>Registration – Closed</b> No further registrations will be allowed for the evening. This is so we can ensure we have the correct number of patrol boats to cover the number of children on the water.
6:30 PM	<b>Briefing</b> The briefing will cover safety notices, the plan for the evening, wind direction & speed. A quick check will be carried out to ensure the cadets are appropriately dressed for that evenings conditions.
