- 8.1 The course will be set in Langstone harbour using a combination of Navigation & laid inflatable buoys

9 SCORING

- 9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
9.2 There is one discard if three races are sailed.
9.3 If two races are sailed there are no discards

10 BERTHING

Facilities for visitors are available at Locks SC, Tudor SC, & Langstone SC

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows

To the 1st three Boats in each fleet for the series

There is a daily prize for the winner on corrected time of each fleet.

If there are more than six one-design boats in a fleet they will receive a series prize and a daily winner prize.
