

## Club Duties

Tudor Sailing Club is a self-help club. This means that the facilities and the services that the club offers are provided by trained members of the sailing club who have volunteered their time. By not employing staff the club is able to keep the membership fees as low as possible. To help manage the self-help ethos we ask each eligible member to offer their time (accrued monthly for new members joining part way through the year) to help operate a club activity.

For 2020 individual and family members are asked to complete a minimum of 15 hours. For family members the 15 hours can be shared between the family members.

We appreciate it may not always be possible to sacrifice 15 hours of time, and in this case the club charges these members a levy based on an hourly rate for the time they are unable to offer. This is set at £10 per hour for members in their first year of membership and £20 per hour thereafter. This levy is aimed to encourage members to participate in helping the club operate.

Members can volunteer for club duties by contacting one of the persons named below:

### Bar & Galley

To serve drinks behind the bar in the clubhouse. Full training will be provided, no previous experience is necessary. Bar duties are available on Wednesday, during cadet sessions (Apr-Sep), Friday evenings and Sunday lunchtimes.

The galley is open on Fridays during the summer (usually a BBQ) and we hope to open on Sundays in future, training will be provided and we welcome members who would like to host their own night.
